## A SINCERE 'THANK YOU'!:

My serious fall in the snow after 10.00 am Mass on Sunday 24th January resulted in severe bruising to my right chest, arm and leg and lack of use of my right arm and hand for several days. I was extremely blessed in not breaking any bones nor in needing hospital treatment and thank the Lord for this, experiencing His Presence as I fell. As Psalm 90 (91) declares;

'For you has He commanded His angels,

To Keep you in all your ways.'

My thanks also to the many parishioners who offered help when they heard of my accident, to those who sent cards and meals and treats; to Barbara for bringing in necessary supplies on those days her work demanded her being in the Parish Office and to Bishop Philip for his telephone messages of prayer and support. Also to Deacon Tony Darroch for providing <u>Liturgies of The Word with Holy Communion</u> last week-end when my shoulder and back were somewhat painful.

## THE HOLY SEASON OF LENT

This begins on Wednesday 17th February, which is Ash Wednesday this year. It is a <u>Day of Fasting and Abstinence</u>, when meat should not be eaten and only one full meal is permitted to those 'who have attained their majority, until the beginning of their sixtieth year' (Canon 1252). Those who are suffering from ill-health and serious medical conditions are not obliged to fast if doing so aggravates their illnesses. Two light snacks (toast, biscuits for example) are permitted if those fasting have need of these, as is water, tea or coffee at any time.

## ASH WEDNESDAY MASSES

Until the end of February, after consultation with members of the St Oswald community, Father Patrick has suspended all Masses at St Oswald's Church because of the pandemic.

Accordingly, there will be a 10.00 am Mass at St Michael's Church as well as the usual 7.30 pm Mass for this day, provided Stewards are available and the requisite cleansing takes place after the morning Mass.

Booking for these Masses, as for all week-end Masses, must be done by telephone, as Father Patrick is still covering this area to enable Mrs Davis to keep to her hours.

<u>Imposition of the Ashes</u> will be given in a different way this year, as mandated by The Congregation for Divine Worship and the Dis-

cipline of the Sacraments on 12th January 2021ad. After the Blessing of the Ashes, the formula of imposition is said once, applying to all present, and the ashes are then sprinkled on the head of each person who comes to receive them, with no words being said. Obviously, no head coverings should be worn at this time of imposition. Face masks to be worn as normal.
